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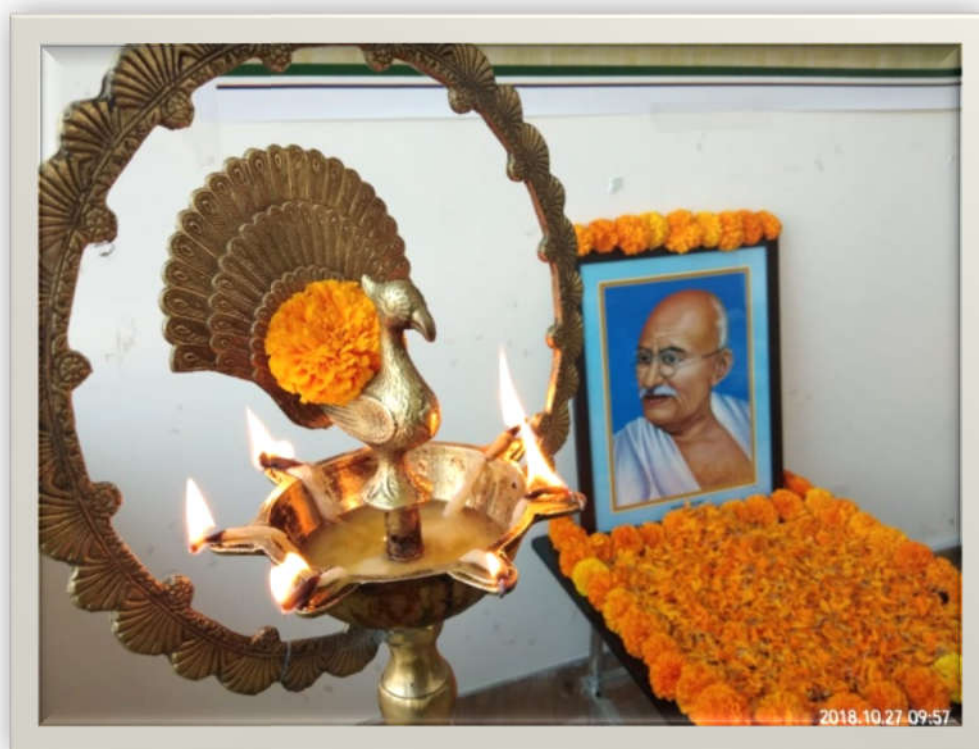

## **Workshop Implementation:**

A one-day Curriculum Development Workshop on NaiTalim, Work Education and Community Engagement was organised by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE) and School of Education, Central University of Haryana, Mahendragarh at the Virtual Classroom, Teaching Block of Central University of Haryana on October 27, 2018 with an aim to incorporate the experiences developed through hand work into the educational curriculum of Teacher Education, B.Ed Courses in the University. The one-day workshop focused around promoting the Gandhiji's ideas on Experiential Learning, NaiTalim, Work Education and Community Engagement.

The workshop began at around 9:30 AM with the lighting of lamp and the floral tributes were paid to the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi Ji. Dr. Parmod Kumar, Dean & Head, School of Education, Central University of Haryana formally welcomed the participants and faculty and provided the background to the theme of the workshop. Resource Person from MGNCRE, Dr. VP Sharma was formally welcomed by the Dean Students Welfare, Prof. Rajesh Malik and Prof. Ranvir Singh, Swami Dayanand Chair, Central University of Haryana, Mehandragarh.

A short video presentation on the community engagement tasks done by the School of Education, CUH was presented at the beginning of the workshop.

In his Inaugural address, Prof. Ranvir Singh, Swami Dayanand Chair, Central University of Haryana stressed on the spiritual relevance of the Gandhiji's Philosophy of NaiTalim. He viewed that the Macaulay's education system wanted us to become clerks and in this mad race of materialistic development we lost the real treasure of education which we inherited since ages. Prof. Singh further highlighted the importance of incorporating NaiTalim in the existing education system. The Profound Knowledge he acquired in Vedic Education was highly motivating. Prof Singh thanked MGNCRE for taking up this task of reinventing the education system, which he summed up by saying that, "we need to reinvent ourselves."

Dr. VP Sharma, Senior Academic Consultant, MGNCRE, Hyderabad in his introductory address to the NaiTalim called for the process of teaching where Head-Hand and Heart are put into work while learning and teaching. In his address Dr Sharma discussed the need for enhancing the B.Ed curricula with work Education and

what work education actually comprises. Dr. Sharma thanked Prof Ranvir Singh for his valuable inputs and Knowledge contribution to the one day workshop being held at the Central University of Haryana.

Further, Prof Rajesh Malik in his presidential address welcomed all the participants to the one day workshop. He provided the background to the NaiTalim and focused on its necessity in the present scenario. He stated that a teacher can be an initiator of change and looked upon this workshop as a process of contributing to the education policy of the country. Formal Vote of thanks was put by Dr Anoj Raj, Associate Professor, and central University of Haryana. He thanked MGNCRE and School of education, CUH for organizing this one day workshop. Dr. Dinesh Chahal, Department of Education moderated the Inaugural session of this one day workshop.

**Tea Break** – A Short Tea break for 20 Minutes was provided to the Participants of the workshop from 11 to 11:20 AM.

### **First Session: 11:30 to 12:30 PM**

The First Session after short tea break was moderated by Dr. VP Sharma where he focused on the methodology and mode of the workshop. Dr. Sharma discussed with the participants key points of the National Curriculum Framework 2005 report and NCFTE 2010 reports. Dr. Sharma continued by discussing the initiatives and the interventions that can be drawn into the existing education system and precisely at the Teacher Education Institutions.

### **Second Session 12:30 - 1:30 PM**

The Second Session of the one day workshop was activity based. The participants present at the Hall were divided into 6 different groups. Copies of NaiTalim curriculum were circulated to all and they were asked to chart out the activities that could be used/made to work during the teaching practice of the B.Ed Students. Further one Group was asked to prepare the Work related activities for the B.Ed students from Modules prepared by the MGNCRE in consultation with different resource persons in the field of education at Universities and SCERT level across the India. The Session was moderated by Priyank Goswami, Programme Coordinator MGNCRE. Participants were given time to read Chapter 6 and Chapter 7 of the NaiTalim and Experiential Learning Curriculum. The session comprised Team

Formation and Group Discussion on curriculum development on NaiTalim and Community Engagement.

**Lunch Break – Participants were provided Lunch Break from 1:30 to 2:30 PM**

**Post Lunch Session – 2:30 to 3:30 PM**

Presentations of the activities prepared in the second session were made by the participants. Different groups presented the activities along with the steps for performing them. They highlighted the subject relevance of these activities which can aid the teaching practices in different class. The activities were made for Class 1 to Class 5. Thirteen different presentations were made of these activities in this session. The session ended with the summary of the key points understood, discussed in this one day curriculum development workshop which was organized by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Hyderabad and School of Education, Central University of Haryana, Mehandragarh.
