# **Cantts discuss** merger roadmap

Secunderabad: Members of civil societies across different Cantonments have collectively urged the ministry of defence (MoD) to merge civilareas of the Cantonments with neighbouring civic bodies and nagar panchayats. to ensure better governance.

On Thursday, representatives of 20 Cantonments of Telangana, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, and Karnataka, which come



under the Southern Command Army headquarters, Pune, met for a one-day interactive session and discussed three major issues including merger of Cantonment's civil areas, implementation of state and central government schemes in the Cantonments and women empowerment. Members said that this was the first meeting after the demand for merger of Cantonment civil areas with neighbouring civic bodies, has been raised by various Cantonments, including Secunderabad Cantonment.

ger issue to mount pressure on the defence ministry. The participants who took partin the session all in support of the merger," said Cantonment Vikas Manch, secretary, Sanki Ravinder, over telephone from Pune. He said this is the first step towards the merger issue and that many such interactions will be held in the future.

According to him representatives of Cantonments from Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh also raised road closure issues, lack of basic amenities, lack of implementation of Central government sponsored schemes and problems that people are facing in their states.

Meanwhile, the resolutions passed at the session will be tabled before the Union defence minister and MoD authorities soon.

## AP doc asks bribe to conduct post-mortem

Vijayawada: A government doctor demanded a bribe of Rs 16,000 for conducting a post-mortem in Udayagiri of Nellore district from a woman who lost her husband.

Erakam Mudhiraju (27) was working as an agricultural labor for a monthly salary in Nellore and was forced to borrow money from others for family expenses. Troubled by the mounting debt, he ended his life on Wednesday.

After receiving the information, police registered a suicide case and sent the body to the Udayagiri government hospital for post-mortem. However, the doctor demanded a bribe of Rs 15,000 and Rs 1000 for the attender and asked the wife of the deceased to send the amount through UPI...

The entire episode was filmed on a mobile phone and went viral on social media. Later, the District collector ordered an inquiry into the matter. The doctor was suspended following the inquiry report. Udayagiri SHO and Varikuntapadu police arranged a private ambulance to their native place and provided financial assistance to the bereaved family. Police also said that no case has been filed against the doctor as no complaint was registered against him.
