

The Personnel Management and Industrial Relations Department is unique in a way as not many departments or universities can boast of having an ex State Minister of Human Resource Development as a faculty member.



After having developed curriculum for 10 Universities in Telangana by integrating SFDRR, UN SDGs & UNFCCC and preparing course material & case studies for transacting curriculum on Rural Communication, Rural Social Work, Rural Engagement for Teacher Education, Rural Entrepreneurship and Common Core Curriculum on Rural Engagement, UNICEF and NCRI will now take forward FDP in Telangana.

Project Objectives:

Undertaking orientation and capacity building programmes using cascade approach : (1) Intensive training to the identified state level resource persons (2) Orientation to the selected resource persons and faculty members of 5 departments in each 10 universities (3) Guidance and handholding support to the faculty members to act as animators.

The faculty development will be undertaken in 10 universities covering identified faculty members in each of the department and NCRI team will provide guidance and support for the curriculum implementation.
