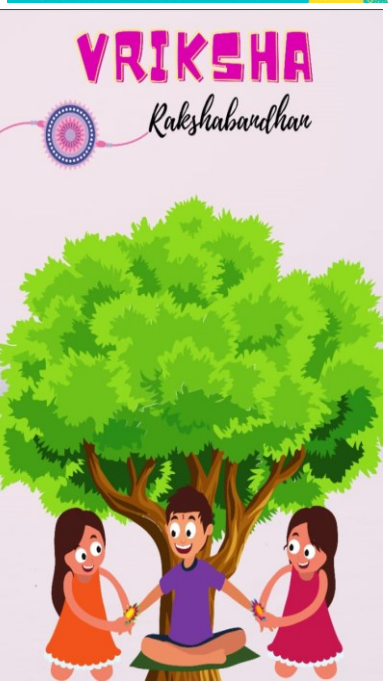
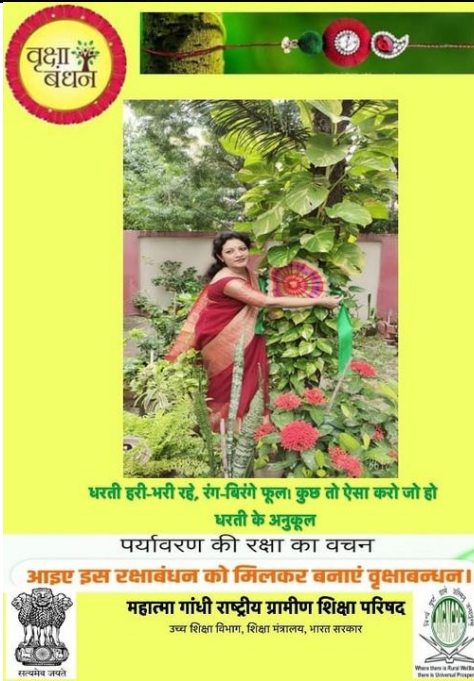

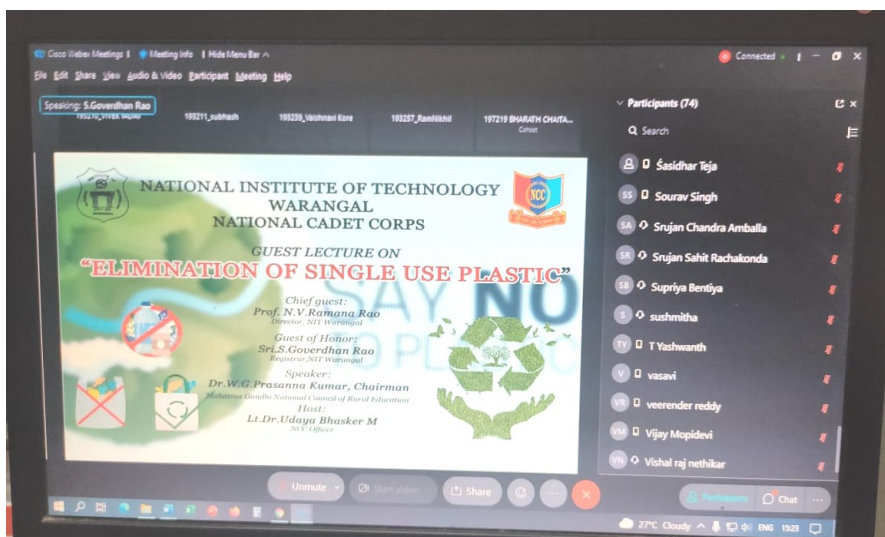


“Every Campus should have a Green Policy in Place. Periodic Audits will ensure sanitation, hygiene and water conservation on campuses” said Chairman MGNCRE as he addressed the distinguished panel in the online webinar organized by Centre for Science and Environment (CSE).



CSE organized an online release of its new publication – **Green Campus Movement** -- and a webinar exclusively for Higher Educational Institutions from across India. Chairman MGNCRE Dr. W G Prasanna Kumar was one of the distinguished Speakers along with Anumita Roy Chowdhury, Executive Director Research and Advocy CSE, Rajneesh Sareen Program Director Sustainable Buildings & Habitat Program CSE, Mitashi Singh Dy. Program Manager Sustainable Buildings & Habitat Program, M S Shyamsundar Adviser NAAC, B S Prabhakar Associate Professor St. Joseph’s College Bengaluru, Ashwani Luthra Director Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Guru Nanak Dev University Amritsar. Participants at the webinar discussed the opportunities that exist for educational campuses to not only to transform their micro-cosystems for practical learning, but also to make measurable impacts towards sustainability.

CSE has launched a ‘Green Campus Initiative’, under which a network of higher education institutions and a ‘Forum of Green Campuses’ have been developed and set up. Forum members have committed to reduce their resource footprints and waste generation and have outlined their initiatives and action plans across the themes of land, air, water, energy and waste.



Chairman MGNCRE delivered a Guest Lecture in a Webinar organized by NIT Warangal on “Elimination of Single Use Plastic”. The session was organized by the Institution’s NCC Cell. 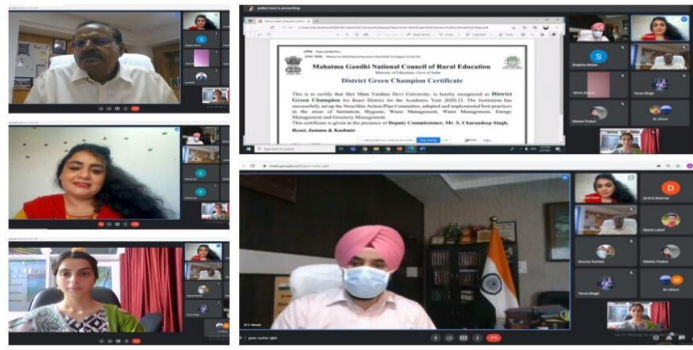
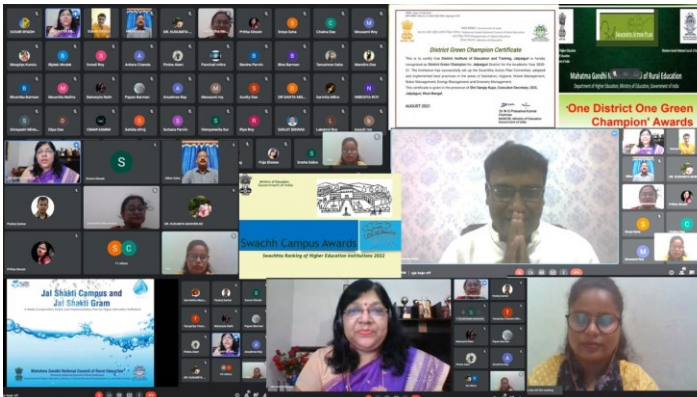

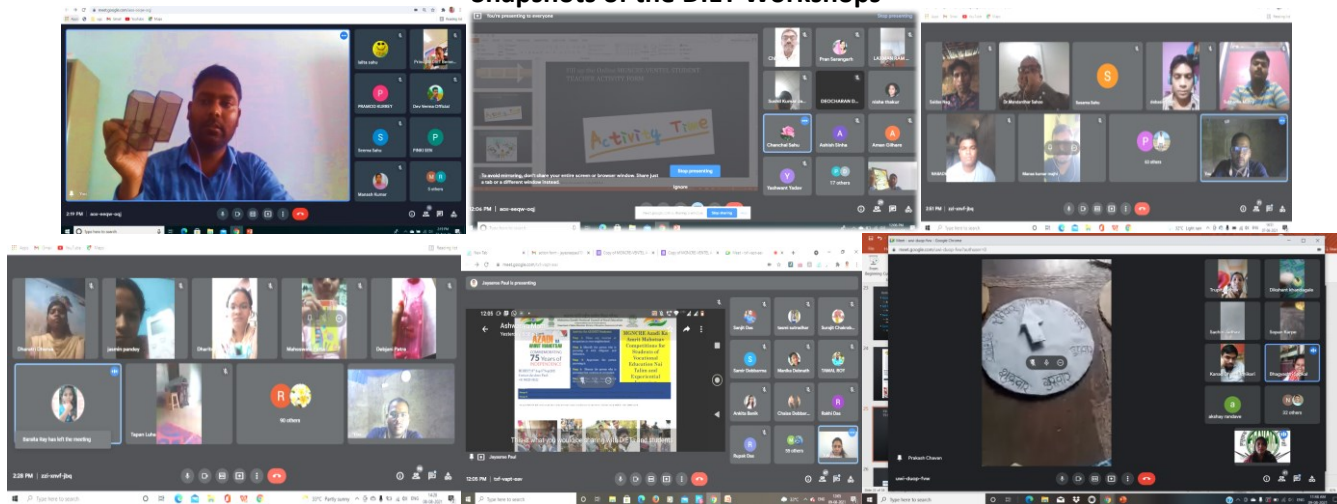

MGNCRE has called for Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Competitions for Students of DIETs who have constituted Vocational Education Cells from 15th August to 5th September 2021. Students will participate in different vocational education activities and the best performing students will be rewarded and the DIET awarded! MGNCRE is working on bringing action on Vocational Education through workshops in each District Institution of Education and Training (DIET) in all the states of India. Each Institutional level workshop has discussion over Vocational Education, Nai Talim and Experiential learning. It also includes the participants exploring experiential learning of Vocational education through the use of tools in the workshop. The explored subject methodologies include Mathematics, Social Science, Language and Science. MGNCRE has **conducted 191 Workshops in DIETs** across India. The response of the DIETs has been positive and student-teachers have shown enthusiasm in their approach towards working on vocational education and implementation of NEP 2020. The discussions in the workshops have been around Nai Talim and subject methodologies, topics around experiential learning and use of tools for different subject methodologies. The workshops have been knowledge houses rich with information sharing and student-teacher interactions over classroom pedagogy and learning of subjects.
