National Conference on Rural Management Education

There is an urgent need to rise above the odds and create an effective management of rural resources for an inclusive growth.

As you would agree appropriate and adequate Rural Management expertise is required for rural India to move forward, as India races towards becoming the third largest economy in the world. Rural India is the store half of bulk of resources needed for development. Two-thirds of the Indian population is also rural while 30% of world's poor are also from rural India.

Indeed this neglect is in sharp contrast to the substantial thought, initiative and resources invested by both government and the private sector in the creation of professional managers for corporate enterprises.

It is primarily the field of Rural Management Education, which in India has produced and directed a slim but steady and impactful stream of management professionals for a variety of such organizations. However, the effect remains very limited, despite the extensive need for such professionals. It is now time for a substantial move forward on the specific actions needed to develop adequate RM capabilities in the country.

Expansion of Rural Management Capabilities

Six key areas had been identified for focused attention to build adequate professional rural management capacities, which need concerted action –

It is now time to act, and the following process is envisaged to enable systematic and quick development with involvement of key stakeholders, in the next one year.

We cordially invite you to the 'National Conference on Rural Management Education'. Through this conference, we strive to bring together institutions, academics, professionals and other key stakeholders to deliberate on strategies for expansion, standardization and improvement in rural management education at various levels.

Areas of focus for the conference are as follows-

- 1. Expansion of RM Programs of various levels and types to meet the different kinds of demand and need, with state support as required for the latter graduate, undergraduate, certificate, diploma and continuing education programs.
- 2. Institution of the requisite opportunities to ensure their engagement in initiatives aimed at rural India, government programs, organizations and initiatives thereof.
- 3. Developing a specialized entry process for young people with the necessary aptitude and orientation into Rural Management Education.

- 4. Development of standardized curricula and quality assurance processes.
- 5. Development of knowledge materials ranging from cases, textbooks and audio-visual products to systematic research to develop the core knowledge for the field.
- 6. Development of appropriately trained/ oriented faculty for the field.

We are sure that as a prominent Rural Management Educationist of your stature, you would actively participate in person in the upcoming National Conference. Your personal participation and contribution is valuable to build a body of practicing knowledge for addressing the challenges in the field of rural management education by universities and higher education institutions.
